Declassified Original Study

1. The workers at Harshaw were “in large proportion edentulous [toothless] or nearly edentulous.”
2. “There was some indication [teeth] may have been etched and polished by [the fluoride acid] ... exposure of the teeth to the acid may have contributed to the attrition [loss of teeth] observed.”
3. The workers were not given protective masks.

Published JADA study 1948

1. Harshaw workers had fewer cavities.
2. “strangely enough, dental erosion or decalcification of enamel and dentin commonly seen in workers exposed to inorganic acids [fluoride] was not seen.”
3. Harshaw workers “preferred to chew tobacco or gum for protection.”
